Spongy bone is found in bones of the pelvis, ribs, breastbone, vertebrae, skull, and at the ends of the arm and leg bones. Joints: An articulation, or joint, is where two bones come together. In terms of the amount of movement they allow, there are three types of joints: immovable, slightly movable and freely movable.

227 228) The paired pectoral girdles each consist of two bones, the anterior clavicle and the posterior scapula. The shoulder girdles function to attach the upper limbs to the axial skeleton. In addition, the bones of the shoulder girdles serve as attachment points for many trunk and neck muscles.
